

Jeep Tour of the Gargano National Park and lunch in masseria



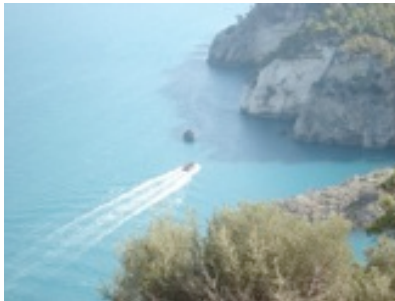
A mystical park in southern Italy offers its beauty to all who visit. The Gargano National Park sits upon high cliffs overlooking the deep blue Mediterranean Sea. This Puglia Amazon flourishes beech fir, turkey oak, maple, carpini, and 61 kinds of orchids in the Park, which is the highest concentration of orchids in Europe! Amongst the flora live fallow deer, woodpeckers, badgers, and much more exotic wildlife. The “carsismo” of this enchanting place continues with a visit to an Italian “masseria.” The “masseria” is an old Italian farm where the direct production of wines, extra virgin olive oil, and cheeses take place. Bring your appetite because you will be expected to eat the fresh organic cuisine extracted from the surrounding Italian land. The food will be specially prepared at the “ristorante” located in the “masseria.”

Hiking to the old Abbey of Monte Sacro



We will hike between the sky and sea to the Benedictine ruins on Monte Sacro. Surrounded by the Adriatic Sea, the trail invites the walking traveler to experience the famously relaxed Italian way of life amidst rugged coastal scenery, farmland seemingly untouched by time, and unique cave-like dwellings. There will be breathtaking sea views that frame the route along a historic coastline punctuated by prehistoric archaeological sites, recalling the region's ancient importance to the Romans and Greeks. Our final destination will be the ancient Benedictine ruins that reveal a view into the past, but still hold many mysteries within its prehistoric walls.
